Gunmen kill 2 vigilance group members in Warri

Gunmen, on Monday, in Warri, Delta State, shot dead two members of a vigilance group.

The two victms were said to be on the trail of some hoodlums, before the tide turned against them as the armed bandits shot at them

The midday incident, the Nigerian Tribune gathered, occurred at Ginuwa area, along Warri/Sapele Road in Warri metropolis

An account said one of the victims, simply identified as Omonigho Monday, alias Omones, who was the chairman of the vigilance group in Agbassa, was in company of his friend, one Odaiah, in the former's house when the gunmen came calling.

The armed men shot at them and Omonigho gave up the ghost instantly while the other, who was attempting to scale a fence, was shot in the head and died while being ferried away via a tricycle to the hospital

There was pandemonium after the incident, as vehicles were turning back and commuters

When Nigerian Tribune got to the scene of the incident, the lifeless body of Omonigho was still lying on the ground and sympathisers making effort to have a glimpse of it.

Meanwhile, investigation revealed that the armed bandits were on the trail of a vehicle that went to a bank to cash money, but in a bid to halt the fleeing robbers, two members of the vigilance group were gunned down.

It was, however, learnt that effort made to catch up with the fleeing robbers by soldiers and policemen failed as the bandits maneuvered their way through Effurun and disappeared into thin air.

Confirming the incident, the Area Commander of Warri Police Command, ACP Rabiu Hussaini, described the incident as unfortunate, adding that his men would surely catch up with the fleeing

According to him, the hoodlums were only lucky to have escaped because most of his men were covering the official visit of the Chief Judge of the state, Justice Zai Smith, to Warri prisons.
















Gunmen kill 2 vigilance group members in Warri
