

Police arraign 37-yr-old for killing wife

THE police, on Tuesday, arraigned a 37-year-old Babatunde Gbolahan, before Justice Aishat Opesanwo, of the Lagos High Court sitting in Igboosere, over allegation of beating his wife to death.

The suspect, who was

arraigned on one-count charge bordering on manslaughter, pleaded not guilty to the charge.

Gbolahan was alleged to have committed the said offence on October 13, 2009.

According to the charge, Gbolahan allegedly had an altercation with his wife, Yemisi, which led to a fight

and he allegedly beat her to death with a belt and turner.

The alleged offence, according to the prosecution, contravenes the provisions of Section 325 of the Criminal Laws of Lagos State.

The case was adjourned till December 2, for the prosecution to produce its witness.
