

2 die in autocrash, Okada accidents

A 300 level distance learning student of the University of Ibadan (U.I), Miss Odinaka Dimoke Felicia, died last Saturday at Barika Bus Stop along U.I.-Ojoo road in Ibadan, Oyo State after she was knocked down by a car while crossing the road.

The distance learning students are currently sitting for their examinations after resumption by lecturers from the prolonged strike by members of Academic Staff Union of Universities (ASUU).

The vehicle, a **Mercedes Benz** with registration number KF 761 KJA, driven by one Mr Ajila Olayinka of Apete area of the city, reportedly hit her while she was busy receiving a call on her phone, and at the same time crossing the road, with a friend.

She reportedly sighted the vehicle too late and in an attempt to step out of the vehicle's way, her foot slipped and she got in the way of the driver who was also trying to avoid hitting her.

She was said to have been rushed to the University College Hospital (UCH), Ibadan by the driver for medical attention but was confirmed dead on arrival.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the deceased's father, who reportedly initially expressed anger when he was called that his daughter had an accident and said she was a disobedient girl because he told her not to travel yet, declined further investigation into the case.
