In a similar incident, a motorcyclist, Yusuf Abideen, lost his life on Sunday, when he and another *Okada* rider, Olayemi Shola ran into each other at WAEC junction along Sango-Eleyele road in Ibadan.

The deceased was said to have been coming from Agbaje area on his *Bajaj* motorcycle with registration number MAP 817 QC at was coming from Sango area with a female passenger on another *Bajaj* motorcycle with registration number MUS 104 QB, before they collided with each other.

The two riders reportedly sustained serious injuries and were rushed to a nearby private hospital for treatment, where Abideen was confirmed dead.

When contacted, the Oyo State Police Public Relations Officer, Olabisi Okuwobi-Ilobanafor, confirmed the two cases, saying that the corpses had been deposited at the State Hospital mortuary, Yemetu, while the car and the motorcycles had been taken to Sango Division for Vehicle Inspection Office's (VIO)
