

One killed in Lagos Maryland accident

ONE person was early Tuesday killed and newspaper vendors injured as a commercial bus rammed into them at the popular Maryland Bus Stop in Lagos State.

Two newspaper agents were seriously injured while scores of pedestrian and students escaped being caught by the vehicle, which was said to be on a high speed.

The lone accident created serious confusion among the vendors and also caused traffic gridlock, before the vehicle and the body were eventually taken away by policemen from Ikeja divisional police station.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the break of the commercial bus failed and the driver, in his efforts to prevent the vehicle from veering into Ikorodu, swerved to where the vendors were selling their papers.

An eye witness, who claimed to be on the other side of the road, when the incident happened, said that the vehicle was coming from Ikeja and heading towards Anthony when the accident happened.
