




Saturday, February 8, brought serious grief to the families of the three men who were said to be close friends who used to hunt together. The joy which welled up within the three families with the arrival of the new baby got suspended as another life trying to assist the family of the baby's father exited the world

Crime Reports gathered that on Friday, February 7, Kamorudeen and Waheed decided to help Emmanuel to hunt for animals to use in serving well wishers after his wife was delivered of a baby boy on Wednesday, February 5. Being hunters who were already used to one another, they did not hesitate in moving into the bush at about 10p.m. that day.

Five hours after, it was learnt, Kamorudeen erroneously shot Waheed where he lay to sleep with Emmanuel while he moved around hunting. He was promptly arrested after the matter was reported at Igbeti Division of the Oyo State Police Command.

Narrating how the incident occurred, Kamorudeen (43), who said he worked as a panel beater aside hunting, told Crime Reports: "We were three friends that used to go hunting together - Oyinwola Emmanuel, Usman Waheed and I. We were known within Igbeti town in Ibarapa zone of Oyo State





as friends and we used to move together.

"On Wednesday, February 5, Emmanuel's wife gave birth to a baby boy. On Friday, February 7, we decided to go hunting to look for animals that would be used for the naming ceremony. We got to the bush at about 10p.m. and started hunting round for our preys. About an hour after, we sighted some guinea fowls which flew away when they saw us.

"Emmanuel and Waheed decided that we should sleep where the fowls flew from till day break so that we would see them very well at dawn but I opposed the idea of sleeping in the bush, telling them that something untoward could happen while we would be sleeping. They agreed with me and we moved from the spot.

"About an hour after again, we got to another place where Waheed sat down and said he wanted to sleep as he was tired. Emmanuel also expressed the desire to join him. I told them I could not sleep since we came to hunt, leaving the comforts of our homes. I left and went round searching for games.

"Around 3.30a.m., I sighted the shiny eyes of what I thought was an animal. I aimed my gun at it and fired. Immediately, I heard the agonizing cry of Waheed, saying 'Yeh! Yeh! Who is that?' I also shouted 'Waheed, what is wrong?' and ran towards him. Emmanuel also stood up. Unknown to me, Waheed did not remove the hunter's torch that we used to hang on our heads and it was that that was caught by my own head torch which I thought were the eyes of an animal.

"I carried him and saw he was hit on the head and chest region. He died immediately. I left Emmanuel with his body, took the motorcycle we rode to the bush and quickly went to inform his family. I also went to Igbeti police station to report myself and I was detained.

"Policemen followed us into the bush and brought out his corpse. He was taken to the hospital mortuary, but I learnt that he had been buried."

He described the incident as fate, saying that he had been trying to avoid going hunting with the deceased for the single reason that he loved to sleep in the bush when they went hunting.

"It was because of the need to help our friend get games for his child's naming ceremony that made me agree to join them because I never liked sleeping in the bush when we were supposed to be hunting."

Kamorudeen also disclosed that the deceased married his first cousin as his second wife after he got separated from his first wife, which made them relations through marriage. "My cousin had a child for him before his death but his former wife had four children," he added.

Also, 36-year-old Emmanuel, the father of the newborn baby, on behalf of who the friends moved to hunt before the unfortunate incident, corroborated Kamorudeen's statement. The furniture maker, who also said that he worked as a night guard, said he was sleeping when he was rudely woken up by his late friend's cry.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Olabisi Okuwobi-Ilobanafor confirmed the incident, saying that Emmanuel and Kamorudeen had been transferred to the State Criminal Investigation Department, Iyaqanku, Ibadan, for further investigation.
