IN its effort to consolidate on curtailing the activities of men of the underworld, men of the Nigerian Police, 'B' Division Command, Warri, Delta State, last Monday night, shot dead an armed robber during a gun duel that lasted for several minutes.


It was gathered that the robbers were confronted after a tip-off from a member of the public, who was said to have alerted the police that he had just been robbed by the gang.


According to the Divisional Police Officer, CSP Garaje Gado, the patrol team, which swung into action immediately, sighted the armed robbery gang minutes after they were alerted and they were confronted.

He said the robbers opened fire on his men immediately they were sighted, after which a gun duel ensued between the police and the robbers.

In the milee, one of the armed robbers was felled by the police bullets while the other two escaped with bullet woulde

CSP Gado said the police had been on the trail of the taxi, a Vento Jetta with registration number FKJ154AR, which the armed robbers had been using to terrorise the area for some time.
