2 die, 6 injured in Ogun auto crash

No fewer than two persons died while about six others were critically injured in two separate auto crashes in Ogun State.

The incidents, Nigerian Tribune learnt, occurred early **Monday morning on the Abeokuta-Sagamu expressway.**

The first accident was said to have occurred around 10:16 a.m. at the Onipepeye village, Obafemi Owode Local Government Area of the state.

A commercial Mitsubishi Spacewagon marked (LAGOS) BDG 810 XK coming from Ketu, in Lagos State and an ash colour Toyota Camry car with registration number (LAGOS) AAA 524 CW, which was heading towards the Sagamu axis, were involved.

The Toyota Camry was said to have skidded off the runway going to Sagamu, thereby colliding with the commercial Mitsubishi car heading for Abeokuta.

Two persons were said to have died on the spot.

Rescue Team Head, Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Agency (TRACE), Commander Adeola Adekoya, confirmed the incident.
