Gunmen kill
18-yr-old in
Yenagoa

ARMED gunmen, on Sunday, threw a gathering of the All Progressives Congress (APC) in Bayelsa State into confusion following a shooting spree in front of the home of one of its leaders, Mr Godwin Sidi, killing an 18-year-old boy.

Many of the residents of the OMPADEC Street, along the Amarata area of the state capital, where the APC leader resides, claimed the gun battle was between two notorious cult groups in the state.

The APC leader, Godwin Sidi, popularly known as Godsidi, expressed concern over the incident and alleged that the gun battle was deliberate, particularly because of his political affiliation and recent comments against the administration of President Goodluck Jonathan and Governor Seriake Dickson.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the gunmen, numbering four, had at about 7:p.m. on Sunday, trailed the murdered 18 years old boy, whose name is yet to be identified, to the OMPADEC Street, and shot him a meter from No.10b, OMPADEC Street, home of the APC leader.
