

2 Outrage as masquerades kill ex-police chief in Akwa Ibom

THE village of Obioakpa
in Oruk Anam Local Gov-
ernment Area, has been
thrown into mourning fol-
lowing the gruesome mur-
der of Mr Attah Johnson
Udom by masquerades.

Udom, a retired Chief
Superintendent of Police
(CSP), was killed in the
early hours of Tuesday,
April 15, 2014, on his way
to Church for early morn-
ing prayers.

Sources told the Ni-
gerian Tribune in Abak
that the late police chief
had been working as an
undercover informant
for the Police, reveal-

ing those behind the ac-
tivities of masquerades
around the area.

"The man became the
target of the masked men
because he had been
working with police to
track down those behind
the dangerous activi-
ties of masquerades," the
source said, adding that
the man died after several
machetes cuts were dealt
on him.

The Police Public Rela-
tions Officer (PPRO), Mr
Etim Dickson (DSP), con-
firmed the incident, saying
investigation was on to ap-
prehend the suspects.
