## Outrage as masquerades kill ex-police chief in Akwa Ibom

in Oruk Anam Local Government Area, has been thrown into mourning following the gruesome murder of Mr Attah Johnson Udom by masquerades.

Udom, a retired Chief Superintendent of Police (CSP), was killed in the early hours of Tuesday, April 15, 2014, on his way to Church for early morning prayers.

Sources told the Nigerian Tribune in Abak that the late police chief had been working as an undercover informant for the Police, reveal-

ing those behind the activities of masquerades around the area.

"The man became the target of the masked men because he had been working with police to track down those behind the dangerous activities of masquerades," the source said, adding that the man died after several machetes cuts were dealt on him.

The Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mr Etim Dickson (DSP), confirmed the incident, saying investigation was on to apprehend the suspects.
