Controversy as DPO kills hotelier in Osun

PANDEMONIUM brokeout in Ilesa, Osun State, on Wednesday, when residents of Ijamo and Otapete areas staged a protest to denounce the alleged killing of a hotelier, simply identified as Monday, by a Divisional Police Officer (DPO) (names withheld).

Nigerian Tribune gathered that Monday was allegely shot twice in the stomach around 10.00 a.m. on Tuesday by the DPO, Ijamo, who led a police team which

raided his brothel in Ijamo, Ilesa.

Credible source informed the *Nigerian Tribune* that unidentified corpse of one person was allegedly found behind the brothel on Sunday and residents of the area promptly reported the matter

to the police, but nothing was done about it.

According to the source, "around 10.00 a.m. on Tuesday, the police, led by the DPO of B' Division stormed the brothel in a raid of the area and in the process, apprehended some persons, including prostitutes.
