## 2 in police net for killing university staffer

TWO suspects have been arrested by the police in Delta State for the killing of a non-academic staffer of Delta State University Abraka, David Akiri.

Reports said the suspects one Okorodudu Humphrey 'm' and Ovode Ernest, emerged from a bush at about 9.45 p.m. on April 27 and shot the man on the leg, while he was alighting from his vehicle to open the gate to his house at Campus 3 compound of the university, in Abraka, and thereafter, escaped. The victim was immediately rushed to the Eku Medical Centre, where he later died.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Celestina Kalu, who confirmed the incident on Thursday, said the suspects would be made to face the full wrath of the law at the end of investigation.

In another development, acting on a tip off, patrol team from Patani Division, in synergy with vigilance men arrested three suspected motorcycle thieves, one Emma Ebinome 'm', 26 years, of Aven town; Patani Salvation Ayawari, 25 years and Clement Peter, 22 years, both of Bomadi town.
