2 people confirmed dead in attack

THE Police in Niger state have confirmed the death of two people who sustained injury during an attack by some suspected armed youths who went on rampage at Chanhaga Local Government of the state.

The ugly incident recently at Alade street, when some armed youths numbering about 70 launched a deadly attack on some defenceless citizens who are residents in the community, leading to the death of two people, while several others sustained different degrees of injuries and had since been taken to the hospitals for treatment.

The state's Police Command Public Relations Officer, Mr. Oguche Richard Adamu confirmed the incident in a brief interview with Sunday Tribune on Saturday in Minna, adding that three people had been arrested and that the suspects were already being investigated by the police in connection with the crime.

Also a visit by our reporter to the troubled community revealed that normalcy has since returned to the area as residents were seen going about their lawful duties without molestation.

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
