### Gunmen kill Delta varsity lecturer

Gunmen, on Sunday, killed a lecturer of the Department of Humanities at the Delta State University, Abraka, Professor Felix Okpilike.

The don, in company with his aged mother and brother, was shot in his car at about 5.00p.m at Iselegu junction, on Ogwashi-Uku-Kwale-Ughelli road.

He was said to be taking the mother with a fractured leg to an undisclosed hospital for treatment when the gunmen attacked.

According to the state Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Celestina Kalu, who confirmed the story on Monday, no arrest had been made while investigation was being intensified.

Meanwhile, Ndokwa people and other eminent Deltans have condemned the killing.

In a swift reaction to the dastardly act, Ndokwa Political Stakeholders Forum (NPSF), in a statement signed by its Secretary General, Mike Oyibosochukwu Nwabueze, called on security agencies in the state to unravel the killers and bring them to book.

The forum also called for the immediate deployment of security personnel to Iselegu junction in order to protect innocent people plying the road from further attack, as a result of the lingering crises between Iselegu and Ibabu communities.

The Secretary General charged the state government and chairmen of Ndokwa East and Ndokwa West to intervene in the matter, and resolve the protracted land dispute which had led to the destruction of lives and properties for too long.
