

Man hacks friend to death over VCD

A 24-year-old man, Success Okon, on Thursday, macheted his friend, simply identified as Solomon to death, over ownership of a Video Compact Disc (VCD).

The incident, which took place at Agunla Onipetesi Camp, in Ile-Oluji-Okeigbo Local Government Area of Ondo State, had, however, thrown the community into confusion.

An argument was said to have ensued between the duo, who were said to be friends over ownership of the VCD, during which Okon allegedly picked a cutlass and macheted Solomon to death.

It was gathered that the crisis started last week, when the deceased approached Okon to give him his VCD, which he claimed belonged to him.

However, Okon was said to have allegedly refused, a development that led to a fight between them before he allegedly macheted the victim on the face and neck.

The victim consequently fell down in a pool of his own blood and was rushed to the hospital by concerned residents, who came to intervene during the fight.

However, the victim was said to have died at the hospital, as efforts made by medical personnel to save him proved abortive. His corpse had since been deposited at the state General Hospital mortuary in Ile-Oluji for autopsy.

Confirming the incident, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mr Wole Ogodo, said Solomon was already dead before the arrival of police on that fateful day.

He added that the case, which was formerly being investigated at Ile-Oluji, had since been transferred to the state Criminal Investigation Department (SCID) in Akure.

The PPRO hinted that the police, as the institution, charged with the mandate of maintaining law and order would not fold its arms and watch anyone take laws into his hands in whatever situation. He wondered how a mundane item like disc could lead to murder.

He, however, advised members of the general public to always settle their differences by reporting to appropriate authorities for action.
