

Lagos NUT loses exco member

MOYOSORE SOLARIN-LAGOS

THE deputy chairman, National Union of Teachers (NUT), Agege, Lagos State branch, Mrs Fatimo Dada, has lost her life due to complications from an auto accident, as she could not be operated on due to the ongoing National Medical Association (NMA) strike.

According to reports gathered by the Nigerian Tribune, the deceased sustained a spinal cord injury in the accident, which occurred on the Sagamu Expressway, on Thursday July 3. She was rushed to a private hospital in Sagamu but was transferred to Eko Hospital in Lagos, as the hospital did not have the facilities to operate on her.

She, however, died late Friday, before doctors at the Eko Hospital could begin operation on her.

Reports indicated that her movement from Sagamu to Lagos further decreased Dada's chances of survival as she was not yet stable.

Speaking with a principal in Lagos State, who pleads anonymity, the deceased might not have died, he noted that the first hospital she was taken to could not operate on her.
