## Lagos NUT loses exco member

## MOYOSORESOLARIN-LAGOS

THE deputy chairman, National Union of Teachers (NUT), Agege, Lagos State branch, Mrs Fatimo Dada, has lost her life due complications from an auto accident, as she could not be operated on due to the ongoing National Medical Association (NMA) strike.

According to reports gathered by the Nigerian Tribune, the deceased sustained a spinal cord injury in the accident, which occurred on the Sagamu Expressway, on Thursday July 3. She was rushed to private hospital in Sagamu but was transferred to Ek Hospital in Lagos, as the hospital did not have the facilities to operate on the her.

She, however, died la Friday, before doctors the Eko Hospital could b gin operation on her.

Reports indicated the movement from Sagar to Lagos further decrease Dada's chances of survivas she was not yet stable.
