

The armed robbers were almost rounding off their activities, when policemen stormed the village and a fierce gun battle, which lasted for over 30 minutes ensued, leading to the death of the armed robbers.

Meanwhile, a detachment of soldiers manning border posts between Edo and Ondo states on Friday evening killed two armed robbers and arrested one.

The two suspected armed robbers, who were identified as Onimisi Adewunmi, a.k.a Ojukwu, and Timothy Balogun, met their Waterloo when they attempted to rob a popular businessman, who operates a cold room at Ibillo in Edo State and Idoani in Ondo State.

The third was said to have sustained gunshot injuries and was being interrogated as at Saturday.
