

# Police kill one for robbing petrol station in Delta

THE police in Delta State have shot dead a man and arrested another after they had robbed a petrol station in Abavo near Agbor at the weekend.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that the duo, operating on a Lifan motorcycle with registration number AGB 278 QN, had attacked a filling station in the town at about 3.30pm on Sunday holding the fuel attendants to ransom.

After collecting money on them, the hoodlums sped off towards Urhonigbe town along the Agbor-Abraka road.

However, luck ran out on them as patrol team of the Dragon Unit of the force accosted them and engaged them in gun duel. One of the robbers was gunned down while the other escaped.

According to the police public relations officer, DSP Celestina Kalu, on Monday, the Abavo vigilante men who had earlier mobilised against the bandits combed the bush and arrested the fleeing suspect identified as Sunday Ngozi while one cut to size locally made gun and a motorcycle were recovered.
