

# Court registrar accused of poisoning boy

## •I gave him Coca-Cola, not concoction —Pastor

A pastor, who is also said to be a Court Registrar, has been arrested by operatives of the

Delta State Police Command of the Nigeria Police for allegedly poisoning a boy with a black liquid substance suspected to be concoction.

The cleric, Pastor Jonathan Ojigbo, of God Solu-

tion Ministry, Ozoro, Delta State, was said to have administered a solution to one Evi Samson during a prayer session on September 28.

Father of the victim, Uwhemwu Samson, said

he took his son to the cleric for prayers over an issue that was not disclosed.

*Sunday Tribune* gathered that during the prayer session, Pastor Ojigbo administered a black concoction to the boy and when it

was night of the same day, his head became swollen and his eyeballs began to pop out. He gave up the ghost the following day.

The suspect, who lives at Erovie Quarters in Ozoro, is said to be a Registrar in a Magistrate Court in the state.

When asked why he administered the black concoction to his client, Pastor Ojigbo said he only administered a bottle of Coca-Cola to the boy and not concoction.

Meanwhile, the suspect

is now in the custody of the police to explain what transpired.

Confirming the arrest in a statement, Delta State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Celestina Kalu, said a shrine was discovered behind the church of the cleric where some charms were recovered.

She added that while investigations were on to unravel the cause of the death of the deceased, an autopsy is being carried out on the remains.

## Pregnant bride-to-be dies in accident 2 weeks to wedding

A four-month pregnant lady, Dolapo Salawu (25), who was preparing for her wedding slated for October 2014 lost her life on Tuesday when the driver of a petrol tanker lost control and crushed her where she stood with her fiancé by
