2 die in separate Abuja accidents

Motorists plying the Mabushi Expressroad were on Saturday thrown into confusion when a woman with a KIA car crashed into a pedestrian bridge in Mabushi which led to her death.

According to an eye witness, the woman was coming from Kubwa, one of the satellite towns in Abuja when she saw the trailer, crashing into the pedestrian bridge as she attempted dodging the trailer.

This is one of the frequent accidents occuring on that expressroad due to high speed by commuters.

According to the FCT Commissioner of Police, Wilson Inalegwu who confirmed that the accident occured around 4pm, he called on Nigerians to ply the expressroad with caution.

The Commissioner of Police who spoke through the FCT Police Public Relations Officer, SP Moshood Jimoh also warned commuters in the FCT not to over speed especially during the ember months.

As of the time this report was filed, policemen have taken charge of the accident scene as they towed the woman's vehicle away and deposited her remains in the mortuary.

SundayTribune gathered that the driver of the trailer which reportedly caused the accident sped away, while the police have commenced investigation into the accident as well as making efforts to locate the driver.

In another development, one male fatality and three persons were injured in another accident which occurred around Wuse market bridge, in Abuja.
