Painful end for Oyo notorious robbers

armed robbers who attacked and dispossessed a family of their valuables at Mabolaje area of Oyo town few hours to the last Eidel-Kabir had met their unfortunate end, according to the Oyo State command.

The state police command disclosed at a press conference that the robbers met their end at the hands of the operatives of Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS).

The three armed robbers, whose identities were unknown, were said to have robbed the household of one Adeniran (surname withheld) at gun point. According to the Commissioner of Police in Oyo State during a press briefing recently, the Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS), Oyo/Ogbomoso annex received information at about 9 p.m. on Friday, October 3, 2014 that five armed robbers had invaded the residence of Adeniran and had dispossessed him and his household of a Toyota Corolla car with registration number FKY 523 QB, the sum of N375,000, phones and other valuables.

Based on the report, Mr Shodipo said, the SARS operatives went towards the direction they were told the hoodlums took and engaged them in a gun duel, resulting in three of them sustaining serious gun injuries while two escaped. The injured suspects reportedly gave up the ghost while being taken to the hospital for medical attention.

Recovered from them were one double barrel pistol, one single barrel pistol, 10 live cartridges, four expended cartridge shells and two toy guns.

Crime Reports learnt that before the armed robbers stormed the house, they had earlier called Adeniran's wife on the phone, telling her that they had details about her and were going to kill her. When she asked them what her of-

But by the time they got to an environment that was not residential, the armed robbers who saw that the police were determined to get them started firing shots. These were replied by the police, and the driver among the hoodlums was the most hit. He was said to have lost control of the car, hitting an

A 44-year-old Augustine Edafiake has been nabbed for putting in the family way a 12-year-old girl living in his neighborhood.

Randy Edafiake himself is a father of five and whom are two teenage daughters.

The victim has been discovered to be three months old pregnant.

Crime Reports gathered that the step mother of the young girl had drawn the attention of the girl's father to some physiological changes in the 12-year old including an enlarging bust line and hips, as well as a new sleeping culture which he had earlier ignored.

Sensing some verac-

ity of the changes, he dragged his daughter to a medical lab for tests which eventually indicated that she was 32 weeks old preg-

On enquiry by her family members, the girl revealed how Edafiake, their neighbour, had been having a carnal knowledge of her each time her step mother was away.

She revealed how she was tipped with between N1, 000 and N1, 500 each time the act was carried out and was also warned by Edafiake not to disclose the clandestine escapade to anyone.

Wife of the randy victim and step mother to the victim also revealed

in her statement that she had been suspicious of a strange understanding between the young girl and

her husband. However, when he was confronted, the accused was said to have initally denied the allegation, but later admitted when he found himself colling off in a police cell at B Division, Warri, Delta State.

Members of his family were said to began to plead for an out-of-court settlement after he eventually confessed to the crime.
