Tanker crushes Okada passenger, injures 3 in Ibadan

Tragedy struck on University of Ibadan-Ojoo road, Ibadan, on Wednesday afternoon, when a trailer crushed to death a passenger on a motorcycle, while three others, including the bike rider and two students sustained various degrees of injuries.

The incident occurred when the Leyland DAF tanker, with registration number AKD 681 XG, enroute Ojoo, ran over the

Boxer motorcycle with registration number QD 462 KNH, which also hit the two JSS3 female students, identified as Akande Rokibat and Adeleke Boluwatife both of Abadina college, who were walking by the side of the road after closing from school.

When the Nigerian Tribune visited, men of the Nigerian Police from Sango Police Station and other security agents were seen clearing the scene of the accident, including the carcass of the unidentified person while blood of the victim smeared the road.

Also, the tanker was moved to Sango Police Station while its driver had been taken in custody for questioning.

Nigerian Tribune gathered further that the two students were rushed to Jaja Clinic, University of Ibadan, where assurances were given that their injuries were minor and were in stable condition. As at the time of filling this report the parents of the injured students had reported at Jaja Clinic.

The life of the Okada rider was said to be on the verge of loss but his whereabouts cum fate was undisclosed.
