Hausa trader killed over revenue collection

A Hausa trader hawking at Mbaise/Douglas road junction, identified as Saidu, was recently sent to the grave when some youths suspected to have come from Owerri Local Government, Imo State had a clash with some Hausa traders.

Trouble was said to have started early on the fateful morning when some youths from the one of the villages in Owerri went to collect revenue from the the Hausa traders who were operating at the junction.

A heated argument reportedly ensued between Hausa men and revenue collectors as the youths insisted that the traders must pay levies on the place they were carrying out their businesses.

Report had it that a trader who insisted that he would not pay pulled out a

weapon and stabbed one of the youths. The youth was said to have retaliated by using a cutlass to inflict injuries on the trader.

The situation almost caused a stampede in Owerri as both traders and passersby ran helter shelter for their lives, with serious traffic that lasted hours along Douglas road by Mbaise road junction.

The ugly situation continued until a team of armed police men and sol-

diers were drafted to the scene to restore order, it was gathered.
