Panic in Osun over discovery of another 2 mutilated corpses

There was palpable fear in Osun State, on Thursday, as two other mutilated corpses were dumped on the popular Ife/Ibadan Expressway, fueling suspicion that suspected ritualists may have been on the prowl in the state.

This development came barely six days after a beheaded corpse of a lady was sighted in an uncompleted building around Magaji neighbourhood in the ancient community of Iwo.

Nigerian Tribune reliably gathered that some suspected ritualists in the early hours of Thursday, allegedly dumped two unidentified and badly mutilated bodies on Ife/Ibadan Expressway.

Checks indicated that the two bodies involved in the latest incident were allegedly dumped at about 100 metres away from each other after Wasinmi, a village on the Ile Ife lane of the Ife/Ibadan dual carriage way.

Though information surrounding the incident was still sketchy as of the time of filing this report, eyewitness told the Nigerian Tribune that almost same parts of the two bodies were missing, giving room to speculations that the unidentified bodies might have been victims of ritual killings.

A man, simply identified as Adekunle, who claimed to be among the first set of people who arrived the scene, said “we strongly suspect that the bodies were dumped as early as 4.00 a.m. From our observation, same parts were missing in the two bodies—heads, private parts and the limbs were cut off.

“We only met the torsos. We could not also determine the gender of the bodies, because unsuspecting vehicles had marched on them, possibly because it was still dark when they were dumped.”

Another resident of Waasinmi, who pleaded anonymity, tasked security agents to intensify surveillance on the area, contending that “cases of ritual killings are usually on the increase during end of the year and election period.”

He asserted that “ritualists, especially those involved in picking unsuspecting passengers on the road may have set up camps in the forest around the expressway. That is why the police should ensure all-day-round monitoring of activities on the road, to put an end to activities of ritualists in the area.”

However, efforts made to get the reaction of the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) of the Osun State police command, Mrs Folasade Odoro, failed, as she was said to be outside the state on official assignment.
