

Driver arraigned for killing 2 siblings

AYOMIDE OWONIBI ODEKANYIN AND
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A 48 year-old *Volkswagen LT* bus driver, Boniface Onwuha, has been arraigned before an Ikeja Magistrate's Court over reckless and dangerous driving which caused the death of one Fausat Fadeke Ajisegiri and Lateef Dada Ajisegiri who were siblings.

The police alleged that Onwuha committed the crime on November 30, 2014, at PWD Bus Stop Ikeja.

According to the prosecutor, Romanus Unuigbo, the offence contravened Section 19 (1) and Section 20 of the road traffic law of Lagos State, 2012.

The charge reads in part, "That you Boniface Onwuha, on the same date and place, drove a *Volkswagen LT* bus with the Lagos State commercial colour with the registration number KSF 127 XE in a reckless and dangerous manner and caused the death Fausat Fadeke Ajisegiri and Lateef Dada Ajisegiri who are siblings."
