Bus kills banker in Ogun

A banker, Mr Akeem Olasunkanmi, was, on Friday, crushed by a commercial bus at Dalemo Bus-Stop, Sango-Ota, Ogun State.

The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reported that Olasunkanmi, a staff member of the Sango-Ota branch of Sterling Bank Plc and a father of four, was killed at about 8.30 a.m. on his way to the office.

A witness, Mr Aderanti Adeyemi, told NAN that the commercial bus with registration number FKJ-352 XN, coming from Sango-Ota, killed the victim in the process of overtaking a Lagos State government-owned LagBus, which was picking passengers on the road.

Adeyemi, who lived on Oluwalogbon Lane, Dalemo, with the victim, attributed the accident to the impatience of the commercial bus driver.

"When the incident happened, we all rushed to the scene and on getting there, I discovered that it was somebody that lived on the same street as me," he said.

Adeyemi said that the bus driver, who first absconded, later reported himself at the Sango-Ota Police Station.

The witness added that the driver of the LagBus that caused the accident also ran away.

Adeyemi said that the victim had been buried in his residence at No. 1, Oluwalogbon Lane, according to Islamic rites. A police source disclosed that the commercial bus driver had been detained for further investigation.
