2 undergraduates, 3 others feared dead in auto crash

TRAGEDY struck in Nnewi, on Monday, when a Delica L300 bus with registration number UR-135-NNE lost control and rammed into Melody Restaurant on Onitsha-Okigwe expressway, Nnewi, where Social Club (UDOGADIMMA) was having its 2015 maiden Annual General Meeting.

The incident claimed the lives of a second year Political Science undergraduate, Mr Kenechukwu Obah and his sister, a first year Law student, Adaeze Obah, at the Delta State University and the University of Benin, respectively, prompting loud wailing by people at the scene.

The driver of the bus and two other passengers at the front seat of the vehicle also lost their lives, leaving the restaurant littered with fragments of human flesh with blood stains all over the building.

Also, some passengers on the bus and members of the Social Club, who were at the annual meeting in the restaurant also sustained varying degrees of injury.
