Military clears terrorists from Monguno, environs

THE armed forces on Monday morning were victorious, as troops in a military operation spearheaded by highly-coordinated air assaults completed their mission of clearing terrorists from Monguno and its environs.

According to the Defence spokesman, Major-General Chris Olukolade, scores of terrorists were killed, while truckloads of rice, beans and other logistics meant for resupply to the terrorists operating around Baga were recovered in the course of the operation.

Olukolade disclosed that

the terrorists suffered serious casualties, while arms and others dangerous equipment were recovered from the terrorists in the operation in Mongonu, Marte and other communities were now fully secured.

He added that the military had embarked on

search to fish out terrorists on the run.

Also, he noted that the air and land operations were ongoing, with aggressive advance towards other designated communities and locations meant to be cleared in the ongoing offensive against the terrorists.
