**EBENEZER ADUROKIYA - WARRI**

A man, thought to be carrying a bag of money, was, last Wednesday afternoon in Warri, shot dead by suspected armed robbers.

The unlucky, unidentified man was attacked along the Soko Estate Road, off Airport Road, Warri, Delta State.

The incident, which left the area deserted for the better part of the day, took place at about 1:00pm.

When **Crime & Security** visited the area at about 3:40p.m, there was palpable fear as shops littering the area were hurriedly shut by owners.

Feelers revealed that the assailants had trailed their victim to a new fuel retail outlet along the road before shooting him dead.

A source from the area of incident said the armed robbery suspects had obviously assumed that the victim was carrying a huge sum of money in a bag into the filling station.

"I think they were armed robbers who must have trailed the man there. I was not around

when it happened, but from what I was told, the robbers must have trailed him there because they believed he was carrying money. Nobody could say if he was carrying money or if those who shot him took anything from him; what everybody saw was that they left him dead," the source, who is resident in the area, stated.

Meanwhile, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) of the Delta State Police Command, DSP Celestina Kalu said the information had not got to her desk as of the time of filing this report.
