Suspected Fulani herdsmen kill 12 in Suswam's LG, sack villages

JOHNSON BABAJIDE-MAKURDI TWELVE persons were re-

ported killed in a renewed crisis between Tiv farmers and Fulani herdsmen in Logo Local Government Area of Benue State on Tuesday night. The suspected Fulani

herdsmen were said to have attacked Tse Tume and Agaraga villages in the crisis that spanned till Wednesday. The assailants also razed over 45 houses and huts in

the affected communities in a renewed attack on the local government area. According to sources, the invaders struck the affected communities at about

8.00p.m on Tuesday, shooting sporadically and chasing the villagers away from their homes. "It was around 8.oop.m
