Easter tragedy: 3 burn to death in auto crash, fire razes store



Three female passengers were, on Friday, burnt to death in an automobile accident on the Abuja-Lokoja road.

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) Sector Commander in the Federal Capital Territory (FCT), Mrs Susan Ajenge, confirmed the incident to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) in Abuja.

Ajenge said that the accident involved a Peugeot 505 Station Wagon and Toyota Corolla vehicles.

She said that the two vehicles burst into flames after colliding near the SHEDA Research Centre at Yan-Goji, Kwalli area council in the FCT.

The commander attributed the accident to dangerous overtaking and warned motorist against reckless driving.

Corpses of the burnt victims have been deposited at the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital (UATH), Gwagwalada, where the survivors are also receiving treatment.

In a related development, fire has gutted a store in Omu-Aran, Irepodun Local Government Area of Kwara State, destroying property estimated at N1 million.

The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reported that the property destroyed in the store located on Aperan Way, included foams, asbestos and other building materials.

The fire was said to have broken out at about 4:00p.m. on Thursday and some sympathisers rushed to the scene to put out the inferno that raged for more than three hours.

The fire also destroyed a vehicle belonging to one Chief Popoola Rufus parked within the premises of the store.

An eye witness, Mrs Aishat Adeniyi, told NAN that she raised alarm when the fire broke out as she was inside the store.

"The fire actually started from the goods packed inside the makeshift store in front of the warehouse before it spread.

"There was no sign of smoke, the only thing I saw was fire raging from the planks, packed inside the makeshift store outside the warehouse where I was sitting and I quickly raised the alarm," Adeniyi said.


