2 die, 4 injured in auto crash

TWO people were confirmed dead, while four were injured in an accident that occurred at the Ibadan end of the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway at 9.48 a.m, on Tuesday.

The incident occurred when an 18-seater bus plunged into the river.

According to RCC men,

who were working at the area which was not far from Dominion University, the driver was on a high speed when one of his back tyres got burst.

He was said to have tried to apply the brake in order to stop the vehicle but could no longer control it as the vehicle plunged into a river.

The vehicle, the **Nige-**

rian Tribune learnt, was coming from Iwo-Road.

Some of those rescued were seen bleeding and waiting for help.

Many of those who stopped were, however, ready to take the victims to the hospital.

A call was said to have been put to the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC)

but they didn't show up early enough as of the time the **Nigerian Tribune**, left the scene of the incident.

Rescue operation was, however, ongoing to bring out those who were trapped in the vehicle.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that the driver and three others sustained no injury.
