Accident claims 2 in Imo

TWO people on Monday were crushed to death on the Owerri-Okigwe Road when a trailer loaded with bags of cement suddenly rammed into the premises of the Imo State Environmental Transformation Commission (ENTRACO), while several others also sustained varied degree of

injuries. According to an eye-witness, who is a staff of ENTRACO, Jude Nnagboro, informed newsmen that the trailer with registration number XB 882 HAL belonging to IBETO Group of Companies, was coming from Okigwe Road on a high speed when it lost control, crashing into the premises of the company.

The accident, which happened at about 12 noon according to an eye-witness left one of those who sustained injuries with two legs chopped off. "The trailer driver, who acted on impulse and fear ran away."

The general manager of ENTRACO, Chief Osuorji, who was full of praises, thanked God for saving his life and his workers.
