A traditional ruler of Kumbun, in Wase Local Government Area of Plateau State, Ponhzi Jessy Miri, has alleged that soldiers, in their large number, on Saturday, swooped on his community, killing over 400 people.

This was just as the Special Task Force (STF) in charge of security in the state said it was just a mere fabrication.

Miri, on Sunday, alleged that over 400 people from Tarok villages, that is Kadarko, Kurmi and Wadata were killed, following invasion of the communities by soldiers.
