1 killed, 31 suspects arrested by police in Kaduna — CP

KADUNA State Commissioner of Police, Alhaji Umar Shehu has confirmed that one person was killed while 31 suspects were arrested by the police for terrorising innocent people, robbery and car snatching.

At a news conference in Kaduna on Thursday, the police commissioner disclosed that 16 members of a group, popularly known as **Sara Suka** were arrested for terrorising the people of Rigasa community in Kaduna metropolis on May 5 which resulted in the death of one person.

According to him, the suspects, who were between the ages of 18 and 30, were arrested in different hideouts, adding that various items including 19 cutlasses, four swords, and two long sticks were recovered from them.

Similarly, eight suspected armed robbers have been arrested in Kaduna, Zaria, Kafachan and Soba, while seven suspected motorcycle snatchers are currently cooling their feet in police cells.

Exhibits recovered from these culprits included 15 guns, 85 live ammunitions, two military camouflage and 14 motorcycles.

The police boss called for continuous cooperation and support from the public, saying, policing is everybody's business.
