## Accident claims 10 in Zamfara

TEN people were reported to have died as a result of a ghastly motor accident at Danmarke town, in Maru Local Government Area of Zamfara State.

Eyewitness told the Nigerian Tribune that the accident occurred on Sunday evening, involving three vehicles.

According to a source, a station wagon Golf loaded with passengers attempted to overtake a truck conveying sugarcane, but instead ran into an incoming Mercedes Benz.

"Both vehicles somer-

saulted several times before passersby stopped at
the scene to assist the victims.

"Ten bodies were identi-

fied and retrieved from the damaged vehicles," the source declared.

As of the time of filing

this report, the corpses had been deposited at mortu-

ary of the Federal Medical Centre, Gusau.

The police imagemaker, DSP Sanusi Amiru, confirmed the accident, but warned motorists to desist from speed and unnecessary overtaking.

He also appealed to the

general public, whose relatives had travelled and had not returned home to go to the hospital for identification.
