Both attacks came barely 24 hours after a bomb planted by unknown persons at a crowded commercial area in Maiduguri exploded and

killed innocent civilians.

The scene of the Maiduguri blast, on Thursday, was about 2km away from the location of Wednesday's attack.

Witnesses said some soldiers were killed.

Premium Times could not establish the kind of vehicle said to have been used by the suicide bomber, as sources gave conflicting accounts.

Some said it was a pickup van loaded with firewood, while others said it was Volkswagen Sharon bus.

A senior officer, who would not want his names mentioned because he was not permitted to speak, confirmed the incident to journalists, but with a different account on the location and affected 'casualties.

"Of course, there was

a blast today, but it was not exactly at the military checkpoint as you said; it was some 60 meters away from it; and it was civilians that were affected," he said.

Bashir Malam, who is also a member of Civilian-JTF, told journalists that some soldiers were killed by the bomb detonated by a suicide bomber who was driving a car coming into the town from Baga.
