

Suicide bomber kills 2, injures 4 in Borno

BORNO State police command, on Sunday, confirmed the killing of two persons after a suspected female suicide bomber detonated an explosive along Baga/Monguno Road.

Commissioner of Police, Aderemi Opadokun, who spoke in an interview with the *News Agency of*

Nigeria (NAN) in Maiduguri, said four persons were also injured.

"A female suicide bomber detonated an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) strapped on her body along Baga/Monguno highway, killing herself and two others on Saturday.

"Four persons sustained

injuries during the attack," he said.

He also confirmed an IED explosion near a military checkpoint in Konduga Local Government Area of the state, in which two persons were injured.

"It is true that we had a suspected 'IED explosion at Tungushe village,' in Konduga Local Govern-

ment Area on Saturday, near a military checkpoint.

"Two persons were injured and are being treated at the hospital," he said.

Opadokun advised residents to be vigilant and report sight of any strange object to the nearest security checkpoint for action.
