

Police arrest 3 suspects for kidnapping, killing 11-yr-old girl

THE Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS) of Ogun State Police Command has arrested three men who allegedly kidnapped an 11-year-old girl, Aminat Ishola, at Arugudu, Ijoko-Ota in Ogun State, and brought her to Ibadan, Oyo State, where she eventually died after eight days in

charmed concoction on the girl, which, according to the confession of the suspects, was meant to make her forget about her home.

The concoction was said to have had grave effect on the girl, leading to her death in the early hours of May 29.

On seeing that the girl had died in their custody,

Damilare and Ajisomo were said to have put the remains of the girl in a sack and dumped it at the roadside close to Ogbere Police Station, Ibadan, at dawn.

Though Aderounmu, said to have been suspected because he was sacked from the girl's guardian's bakery, was arrested by the policemen from Agbado

Division on May 25, Adejobi said he denied knowledge of the kidnap of the girl, and was transferred to SARS for investigation.

Nigerian Tribune further gathered that the suspects continued to mount pressure on the deceased's girl's family for ransom which was negotiated from N2million to N300,000.
