

Rainstorm kills 2, destroys cash crops in Kano

TWO persons were killed following a torrential rainfall in Tudun Wada Local Government Area of Kano State on Tuesday.

The downpour also destroyed cash crops worth millions of naira.

The chairman of the local government area, Mallam Ibrahim Nayola, told reporters in

Kano on Wednesday that the rain which lasted for many hours caused flooding and destroyed many buildings.

Nayola said he had already visited the affected areas to assess the magnitude of damage.

While sympathising with the victims, Nayola described the incident as

an act of God.

He urged the them to be patient as efforts were being made to provide them with relief materials to alleviate their suffering.

He said the council had already informed the state government through the Ministry for Local Government for possible assistance to the victims.
