Court remands 24-yr-old man over alleged murder

OLAYINKA OLUKOYA - ABEOKUTA

A 24-year-old man, Idris Adejumo, has been remanded in prison by an Ogun State Magistrates' court sitting in Ota, on Thursday, over alleged murder of one Sunday Adefuye, at Ogba-Ayo in Ijoko-Ota area of the state.

The suspect was arraigned on a two-count charge of conspiracy to commit murder and the

unlawful killing of the apprentice technician, which was committed on August 5.

The police prosecutor, Sergeant Chudu Sylvanus, said the accused person committed the offence punishable under Section 324 of the Criminal Code Laws of Ogun State, 2006 and that the second charge contravened Section 316 and also punishable under Section 319 of the same

law.

The Investigating Police Officer (IPO), said the accused person committed the offence alongside with some others, who are still at large by killing the apprentice with a gun.

The senior magistrate, S. O. Banwo, ordered that the accused be remanded in Oba prison and thereafter, adjourned the matter till November 10, for further hearing.
