Truck container hits high-tension cable, electrocutes conductor

A truck conductor was early on Wednesday morning electrocuted.

The unidentified conductor died in the incident while his driver and one other person sustained injuries around Jakande Estate area of Isolo in the state.

The container, at the

back of the truck which was heading towards a warehouse at Jakande Estate, reportedly hit a high tension cable and the three occupants were trapped.

One of the conductors and the driver were rescued with varying degrees of injuries while the other conductor died. Rasak Fadipe confirmed incident to Lagos Metro and enjoined drivers of high vehicles to be always cautious of electric cable and poles.

Ibrahim Farinloye, the spokesperson of the National Emergency Management Agency, also confirmed the death of the conductor to Lagos Metro.
