Bread hawker remanded for stabbing customer to death

A 44-year-old man, Obafemi Yunus has been arraigned before an Ebute-Metta Magistrates' Court for allegedly killing one Ajayi Peter with a knife.

Trouble was said to have started at a roundabout on Church Street where the defendant sells bread, when the deceased tried to prevail on Yusuf to give him a loaf of bread.

The development led to a scuffle, and Yunus went for

a knife with which he stabbed the deceased in the head.

It was gathered that Peter was rushed to Makoko Medical Centre where he later gave up the ghost. Yunus pleaded not guilty when the charge was read to him.

Upon the plea of the defendant, the presiding magistrate, Mrs. A.O. Ajibaye ordered that Yunus be remanded in prison custody pending legal advice from the DPP and also a duplicate case file should be forwarded to the DPP office.

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
