## Fire outbreak kills 3-year-old girl, destroys agric produce in Jigawa

A three-year-old girl, Hajara Aminu, has been killed in a fire accident, at Kudai village, in Birniwa Local Government Area of Jigawa State.

This was disclosed by the Jigawa State Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Abdul Jinjiri, in a telephone interview with the Nigerian Tribune. He said the little Aminu was sleeping in her mother's room when the fire started.

The police public relations officersaid seven houses was razed by fire, including the house of the village head.

According to DSP Jinjiri, the inferno, which started when the villagers were observing afternoon prayer from the house of village head, also killed domestic animals.

The police spokesman added that the fire also destroyed all the victims'agricultural produce, harvested in the last rainy season.

DSP Jinjiri revealed that the source of the inferno was yet to be known, as investigation was still ongoing.
