

Heavy shooting, near diversion of materials

Minister of Transport, Rotimi Amaechi, voted in his Ward 8, Unit 4 at about 12:55 p.m., even as there was a reported heavy shooting in Abalama in Akuku-Toru Local Government Area.

There was low turnout of voters in Omoku community in Ogba/Egbema/Ndoni Local Government Area, a development said to have been due to the massive deployment of JTF soldiers to the area.

There were heavy and sporadic shootings in Abonemma, in Akuku-Toru Local Government Area, which lasted over 30 minutes, following a clash by two people over the movement of election materials to Kola community.

The materials meant for Ward 4, Unit 11, along Mile 2 Port Harcourt were almost diverted but for some PDP supporters who prevented such an action, allegedly perpetrated by one agent of the All Progressives Congress (APC).

Four persons were reportedly killed in Eleme Local Government Area, while another person was shot dead in Noha in Tai Local Government Area and a shooting was reported in Omagwa, on the way to Ubima, the community of former governor Amaechi
