Unidentified gunmen kills a returnee graduate in Kaduna

THREE unidentified gunmen are currently on the run after killing in Kaduna, a 27-year old man, Mohammed Rabi'u, who had just returned from studies in Malaysia in Kaduna.

Arewa findings gathered that the deceased was shot in his car around 8:30 pm on Saturday after driving in from Abuja in company of his friend.

Narrating the incident, in an interview the deceased's friend, Jafar Ibrahim Ali, who survived the attack, said when they arrived Kaduna, they drove straight to see one of the deceased friends on Lugard Hall, but were told had gone out.

According to him, they asked for his

friend's number and it was while they were waiting to collect the number that a tricycle parked near them and three men alighted from it and made straight to where they parked and demanded they hand over their phones.

"Initially, we thought they were policemen because they were pointing guns at us, but the next thing I heard was gun shot," he said.

It was gathered that the gun man that stood by the deceased's window and was pointing the gun at him, shot him. He fell and was gasping for breath, but his friend grabbed the gun pointing at him and diverted the barrel before a shot rang through.
