

Hoodlum stabs 23-year-old student to death in Kano

TRAGEDY struck last Saturday in Kano State when a 23-year-old SSS 2 student, Rabi'u Dan Maraya, was stabbed to death by a suspected hoodlum following his refusal to surrender cash in his possession to the assailant.

According to investigation, the victim, a student of Mohammed Vice Adamu Secondary School, Fagge, Kano, was on his way home from school when he was accosted by the assailant. He reportedly ordered him to surrender any money in his possession, which the victim refused.

However, when Rabi'u refused to surrender cash in his possession, the assailant, simply identified as 'Jay Jay Okocha', in company with his friend (identity unknown), trailed Rabi'u to a corner where he stabbed him thrice at different spots.

Rabi'u was said to have bled profusely before he slumped. Though he was rushed to a nearby hospital, he died on the way.

He stated that investigation had since commenced on the case, assuring that the culprit would be brought to book.
