## Gunmen kill UN official, 3 Nigerians, one Cameroonian in Adamawa

A United Nations (UN) independent contractor, three officials of the Adamawa State Ministry of Land and Survey and one Cameroonian have been killed in a village in Toungo Local Government Area of Adamawa Sources, according to Eagle Online, said on Wednesday that the men were on official assignment.

They were reported to be demarcating the boundary of some villages between Cameroon and Nigeria.

One of the victims was

identified simply as Zakaria, a director of the state Ministry of Land and Survey.

Reacting to the development, the United Nations (UN) condemned an attack against the UN monitoring team near the Ni-

geria-Cameroon border.

The UN envoy for West Africa and the Sahel, Mohamed Chambas, in a statement, called on both Nigeria and Cameroon to take action to bring the perpetrators to justice.

"According to prelim-

inary reports, at around 14.00 hours on Tuesday, an unknown armed group attacked a UN technical monitoring team, killing five individuals — a UN independent contractor, three Nigerians nationals and one Cameroonian national — and injuring several others.
